

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
OITA INTERNATIONAL CARE CO-OP, Oita, JAPAN
AND

RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY RATTANAKOSIN, THAILAND

OITA INTERNATIONAL CARE CO-OP, Japan (hereinafter referred to as "OIC") and Rajamangala University of Technology Rattanakosin, Thailand (hereinafter referred to as "RMUTR") hereby agree to develop academic and industrial cooperation on the basis of equality in order to promote sustainable partnership and mutual understanding between the two organizations.

Scope of activities

OIC and RMUTR aim to undertake academic-industrial cooperation in areas that may include, but are not restricted to, the following activities:

- (1) Improve curriculum and teaching of the RMUTR to produce graduates relating to the need of Japanese entrepreneurs,
- (2) Promote international cooperative education,
- (3) Enable students' opportunities to apply academic theories to practical situation.

Activity agreements

Before any activity may be implemented, the parties shall discuss the relevant issues to the satisfaction of each party and enter into specific activity agreements base on the mutually agreed objectives and outcome of the activity. Activity agreements will include such terms as the following:

- (1) Elaboration of the responsibilities of each party for the agreed upon activity,
- (2) Specific schedules for the activity,
- (3) Budgets and sources of finances for the activity,
- (4) Any other items deemed necessary for the efficient management of the activity.

Duration of the Agreement

This agreement shall become effective when the representatives of both Parties sign below, and shall remain effective for a period of three (3) years. The agreement shall be renewed for a further period by written agreement between both Parties.

Revision and Termination of the Agreement

Both Parties shall send written notice and consult with each other at least six months prior to revision or termination of this agreement.


Should any questions on any part of this agreement arise, both Parties must consult with another party in order to find a mutually agreeable solution.
